aloha compadre latinxs in hawai'i is the first book to examine the collective history and contemporary experiences of the latinx population of hawai'i this study reveals that contrary to popular discourse latinx migration to hawai'i is not a recent event in the national memory of the united states for example the latinx population of hawai'i is often portrayed as recent arrivals and not as long term historical communities with a presence that precedes the formation of statehood itself historically speaking latinxs have been voyaging to the hawaiian islands for over one hundred and ninety years from the early 1830s to the present they continue to help shape hawai'i s history yet their contributions are often overlooked latinxs have been a part of the cultural landscape of hawai'i prior to annexation territorial status and statehood in 1959 aloha compadre also explores the expanding boundaries of latinx migration beyond the western hemisphere and into oceania

from out of the shadows was the first full study of mexican american women in the twentieth century beginning with the first wave of mexican women crossing the border early in the century historian vicki l ruiz reveals the struggles they have faced and the communities they have built in a narrative enhanced by interviews and personal stories she shows how from labor camps boxcar settlements and urban barrios mexican women nurtured families worked for wages built extended networks and participated in community associations efforts that helped mexican americans find their own place in america she also narrates the tensions that arose between generations as the parents tried to rein in young daughters eager to adopt american ways finally the book highlights the various forms of political protest initiated by mexican american women including civil rights activity and protests against the war in vietnam for this new edition of from out of the shadows ruiz has written an afterword that continues the story of the mexicana experience in the united states as well as outlines new additions to the growing field of latina history

this vital addition to springer s educating the young child series addresses gaps in the literature on father involvement in the lives of young children a topic with a fast rising profile in today s world of female breadwinners and single parent households while the significant body of theoretical understanding and empirical data accumulated in recent decades has done much to characterize the fluidity of evolving notions of fatherhood the impact of this understanding on policy and legal frameworks has been uneven at an international level in a field where groups of fathers were until recently marginalized in research this book adopts a refreshingly inclusive attitude aiming to motivate researchers to capture

the nuanced practices of fathers in minority groups such as those who are homeless gay imprisoned raising a disabled child or from ethnically distinct backgrounds including mexican and african american and indigenous fathers the volume includes chapters highlighting the unique challenges and possibilities of father involvement in their children s early years of development contributing authors have integrated theories research policies and programs on father involvement so as to attract readers with diverse interest and expertise and material from selected countries in asia australia and africa as well as north america evinces the international scope of their analysis their often interdisciplinary analyses draw too on historical and cultural legacies even as they project a vision of the future in which fathers involvement in their young children s lives develops alongside the changing political economic and educational landscapes around the world

movie musicals are among the most quintessentially american art forms often celebrating mobility self expression and the pursuit of one s dreams but like america itself the hollywood musical draws from many distinct ethnic traditions in this illuminating new study desirée j garcia examines the lesser known folk musicals from early african american yiddish and mexican filmmakers revealing how these were essential ingredients in the melting pot of the hollywood musical the migration of musical film shows how the folk musical was rooted in the challenges faced by immigrants and migrants who had to adapt to new environments balancing american individualism with family values and cultural traditions uncovering fresh material from film industry archives garcia considers how folk musicals were initially marginal productions designed to appeal to specific minority audiences and yet introduced themes that were gradually assimilated into the hollywood mainstream no other book offers a comparative historical study of the folk musical from the first sound films in the 1920s to the genre s resurgence in the 1970s and 1980s using an illustrative rather than comprehensive approach garcia focuses on significant moments in the sub genre and rarely studied films such as allá en el rancho grande along with familiar favorites that drew inspiration from earlier folk musicals everything from the wizard of oz to zoot suit if you think of movie musicals simply as escapist mainstream entertainment the migration of musical film is sure to leave you singing a different tune

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
