worlds apart social inequality in a global age third edition is intended as the primary text for upper level undergraduate and graduate students who are enrolled in social stratification and inequality courses primarily taught in sociology departments this book focuses primarily on social inequalities in the american context however a trend in this course is how the global inequalities are effecting and affected by social stratification and inequality in america this edition reflects that trend

a quiet revolution is taking place in america s forests once seen primarily as stands of timber our woodlands are now prized as a rich source of a wide range of commodities from wild mushrooms and maple sugar to hundreds of medicinal plants whose uses have only begun to be fully realized now as timber harvesting becomes more mechanized and requires less labor the image of the lumberjack is being replaced by that of the forager this book provides the first comprehensive examination of nontimber forest products ntfps in the united states illustrating their diverse importance describing the people who harvest them and outlining the steps that are being

taken to ensure access to them as the first extensive national overview of ntfp policy and management specific to the united states it brings together research from numerous disciplines and analytical perspectives such as economics mycology history ecology law entomology forestry geography and anthropology in order to provide a cohesive picture of the current and potential role of ntfps the contributors review the state of scientific knowledge of ntfps by offering a survey of commercial and noncommercial products an overview of uses and users and discussions of sustainable management issues associated with ecology cultural traditions forest policy and commerce they examine some of the major social economic and biological benefits of ntfps while also addressing the potential negative consequences of ntfp harvesting on forest ecosystems and on ntfp species populations within this wealth of information are rich accounts of ntfp use drawn from all parts of the american landscape from the pacific northwest to the caribbean from honey production to a review of nontimber forest economies still active in the united states such as the ojibway harvest of plants recounted here the book takes in the whole breadth of recent ntfp issues including ecological concerns associated with the expansion of ntfp markets and ntfp tenure issues on federally managed lands no other volume offers such a comprehensive overview of ntfps in north america by examining all aspects of these products it contributes to the development of more sophisticated policy and management frameworks for not only ensuring their ongoing use but also protecting the future of our forests

making a world of difference provides a context for the whole debate about the relationship of people and computers it looks at the role of is it in a modern society and the way it impacts on people companies economics etc

international monetary reform is of vital importance to the countries of the world although many studies have been made of the structure and problems of the international payment mechanism few provide an analytical survey of the international monetary system this study analyzes the structural and operational limitations of past systems as well as the major reform proposals for modifying and or replacing the current system with a new payment mechanism the authors describe the structure and nature of the international payment system and identify the issues relating to international adjustment liquidity and confidence they discuss the nature of international liquidity including liquidity s purpose sources of demand and supply and potential shortcomings they analyze the theoretical and empirical implications of the gold standard of primary concern is the extent to which the actual operations of the system corresponded to the theoretical role of the gold standard and the nature and limitations of the so called dollar

gold system that prevailed in the past quarter century until 1971 the major reform proposals of the international payment mechanism are next discussed included are the proposals of historical interest such as keynes triffin bernstein stamp angell rueff and the currently debated issues of the special drawing rights standard freely floating exchange rates and the wider band and crawling pegged exchange rate mechanisms finally the authors analyze the nature operation and future role of the managed float exchange rate system which resulted from the international monetary crisis of 1973 of particular interest are the effects of the organization of petroleum exporting countries opec cartel on the u s dollar as a reserve currency and the monetary effects of the cartel s balance of payments surplus on the world financial markets this study provides the historical background the institutional framework and a balanced analysis of problems involved in the international monetary system it will be of interest to all students of economics and finance and should be read by anyone wishing to understand the world of ever expanding trade

this examination of the role of agriculture and food in the new international division of labor argues that the globalized economy creates new winners and losers

in the violent world of radical extremists the enemy of my enemy is my friend this study reveals how that precept plays out in the unexpected bonding between militant islam and the extreme right in america and europe it provides an insightful and sane look at the possibilities for collaboration between these groups

the authors of this volume argue that urban education is in urgent need of reform and that although there have been plenty of innovative and even promising attempts to improve conditions most have been doomed the reason for this they agree lies in the failure of our major cities to develop their civic capacity the ability to build and maintain a broad social and political coalition across all sectors of the urban community in pursuit of a common goal

with seven of its justices appointed by republican presidents today s supreme court has significantly altered america s legal landscape since 1986 by tilting constitutional jurisprudence to the right that was the goal of presidents reagan and bush in filling court vacancies and has been felt in cases related to federalism economic rights and affirmative action however liberal issues such as abortion have moved only marginally to the right while rulings by the court on school prayer and gay rights have moved constitutional doctrine slightly to the left in this collection of original articles prominent constitutional scholars

are joined by new voices from the cutting edge of academia to subject the rehnquist court to closer scrutiny and to show that its brand of conservatism is less extreme than many have supposed reflecting views across the political spectrum the contributors help readers understand the court dynamic its constrained conservatism and the forces that shape constitutional law in general as these authors show the overall pattern of decision making in the rehnquist era cannot be attributed to any single unified approach to constitutional analysis instead today s court can only be understood as the product of a complex interaction among individual justices each with an idiosyncratic view of the proper interpretation of the constitution and the role of the court in the american political system these provocative essays are designed to provide readers with insight into this interaction by focusing on each member of the bench from the staunch conservatism of clarence thomas to the accommodationism of sandra day o connor to the liberal constitutionalism of david souter the essays analyze the unique approach of each justice to interpreting the constitution they also show that the current justices are the product of a nomination and confirmation process that has undergone a major transformation in recent decades one which favors experienced often unknown jurists over high profile public servants by concentrating attention on its members rehnquist justice allows us to better understand the supreme court as a whole and by assessing today s judiciary in light of a public philosophy that looks askance at government it shows us that the supreme court has truly become a mirror of its times
